NEW BUCS Away Team arrangements



- Away teams will now go from the Arena at Plock Court, where buses will collect teams from the tennis centre
- The teams will be situated in the classrooms or in the Reception area
- Please do not arrive too early before your leave time but you can support home matches (20-minute max if waiting)
- You will be able to collect all your Away Forms as usual, but you may have to find me in reception. PLEASE COLLECT THEM FROM ME
- If you are using the SU 9-Seater you will still be required to leave from Oxstalls. This may mean, getting away forms in advance. This should be organised with myself, otherwise you may have to collect the forms from the Arena

TEAMGLOS Memberships and club Memberships



- It is your responsibility (in collaboration with the SU) that your players on your team sheets have paid their memberships
- We will be checking this at training sessions and before teams get on the bus
- YOU ARE NOT INSURED without this
- It is vital that the TEAMGLOS membership <u>and</u> your club membership is purchased as this benefits your clubs spending



- It is your club's responsibility to take care of your match day kit, this includes washing it!
- It may be sensible to purchase a bag from your club account to keep it safe if you already do not own one
- You should all be in matching Akuma kit, if you do not have this, please speak to Beck
- Any SU owned kit that is lost, will be reordered using the club's account

Entering Results

- If you are the home team it is your team's responsibility to enter the results on BUCS play
- You need to send home AND away match scores to me straight after the match so I can approve them on BUCS play with the opposition
- Without you sending it, I cannot compare an away teams score, which could be incorrect





TEAM

- If you have a coach, they will select the team
- It is then your responsibility to input this onto BUCS Play
- The deadline to upload team sheets is either a Tuesday (All BUCS sports) or Saturday (American Football)



- Any additional BUCS competitions outside of your weekly Wednesday fixtures will not be funded by the SU
- If you would still like to enter but use your club fund to pay, you will still need to go through myself
- I can also assist with booking the transport; however, this will still need to be paid by the club
- Prioritise your club's development and whether these competitions are beneficial
- You can still organise friendlies for a much smaller cost to the club





Playing under protest

- REG 12.1 If a team feels, upon arrival or during a fixture, that the conditions do not adhere to those outlined in the BUCS rules and regulations, they should complete a 'BUCS Playing Under Protest Form' (Appendix 8) as soon as the grievance is noted. All teams are advised to carry with them at least two hard copies of the form so that they are adequately prepared for any such scenario
- REG 12.3.3.1 Refusal to sign may result in a charge of misconduct being raised against the institution/Playing Entity and appropriate disciplinary action taken in accordance with REG 5.





 REG 12.4 Teams are advised to also gather evidence to support any grievances raised on a Playing Under Protest Form, for example time and date stamped photographs or videos, or written statements from match officials.

- I have until 5pm the day after the match to submit the appeal so it is essential that the form is given to me through my office door that day or the next day

Respect: .

- Respect your team mates and your opposistion. While playing & spectating.
- Respect your team coach, they are here to help you develop and grow.
- Respect the decisions made by officials even if you think they're wrong. Matches can't happen without them.
- Respect the drivers and vehicles, it's their license at risk if you do something wrong. That
 means no drinking on the bus.
- · Respect the clubs equipment; if things break, let us know.
- Respect the facilities of away venues, treat them how you would treat our own. Clean up after yourselves, and leave it how you found it, if not better.

Matchday Expectations

- If something goes wrong, inform me!
- It is not acceptable to inform me the day before a match if you cannot field a team (certain exemptions apply)
- Are your club spectators, being respectful on the sidelines?
- Have you tried to influence a player's behaviour and it has not worked, inform me I can help!
- Are you on the pitch and you are receiving abuse on the sideline, report to the match official immediately. At your next break in play, alert a member of staff
