## Job Details

**Job Title:** Community Garden Art Volunteer.

**Location:** Park or FCH community garden (option to support at external Community Rest Garden located on Tewkesbury Road).

**Department:** Student Voice Team, Food Equality Project.

**Hours:** There are no required minimum hours for this volunteer role. The more you engage with the role, the more you may be able to get out of it.

**Working Days:** The garden at Park and FCH are open to students Monday to Sunday. There are set days that staff will be on site to support different roles. Volunteers can attend pre-planned sessions and attend when they are available. CRG is open Tuesday and Thursday, with scope to be available on further days.

### Main purpose of the job
